



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Advent Season: Pray that during this Advent season, God would give our people many opportunities to share the gospel (Rom. 10:14-15, Acts 4:23-31). Pray that our love and actions would adorn the gospel we proclaim (Tit. 2:10; Col. 4:2-6). Pray that our worship services would clearly display the beauty of the Incarnate Christ and many would be drawn to Him (Jn. 1:1-18).

Angel Tree Ministry: Pray for the local kids who will be receiving Christmas gifts in the coming weeks, from our church. Pray that they would not only feel loved by their incarcerated parent and Faith Church, but they would see in our generosity the love of Christ and turn to Him with faith and repentance (Mk. 1:14-15).

Barret & Dayna Brown with CRU in Florida: Praise God they have endured two huge storms in Orlando and are doing well! Pray for Barrett as he works to help two departments within CRU (Unto & the Jesus Film) to work together efficiently and steward their gospel work more effectively (2 Tim. 1:14). Pray for the CRU staff the Browns coach, to faithfully engage people with the gospel (1 Thess. 2:8) and trust the Spirit's work (Jn. 16:8-11).

<u>Our Unity:</u> Pray that our church would continue to "maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Eph. 4:3). Pray that our church would "be one" just as the Father and Son are one, so that "the world may know" of God's love (Jn. 17:21-23). Pray that we would be "kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another," just as God in Christ has forgiven each of us (Eph. 4:32).

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our newly elected and current governing authorities, like Governor DeWine, President Biden, and others (1 Tim. 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with character, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective governmental leadership, "so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity."

<u>Our Finances:</u> Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phi. 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Confession/Lament

As sinners in a fallen world, we need to honestly acknowledge the brokenness in us and in the world around us. We take time in our gatherings each Sunday to do this with either a "Confession" of our sins or a "Lament" of our struggles. The Scriptures give us a voice to cry out for God's light to shine in our darkness, and each Sunday we want to have the opportunity to corporately humble ourselves before our holy and merciful God. This may involve a song, a Scripture passage for reflection, a moment of silence, and/or a responsive reading/prayer (1 John 1:9; 1 Peter 5:7).
