



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Those Struggling with Addictions: Pray for those in our midst who are struggling with addictions. Pray they would repent of their sins and seek forgiveness (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray they would find practical wisdom (Prov. 3:21-23) and supportive friends in our church family (1 Thess. 5:11) that can help them live a stable, addictions-free, God-pleasing life (Phil 2:12-16).

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our governing authorities, like Governor DeWine, President Biden, and others (1 Tim. 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with character, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective governmental leadership, "so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity."

Todd and Kristi Hiltibran with EFCA Europe in Hungary: Pray for Todd's team that leads 140 missionary families in church planting across Europe (Acts 13:1-3). Pray for Todd and Kristi as they minister the gospel and care for refugees, displaced by the war in Ukraine. Pray for spiritual strength (Eph. 1:15-23) and gospel opportunities (Acts 4:23-31) for Kristi as she leads an international school in Budapest, where 40 of the 275 students are from Ukrainian refugee families.

Our Staff: Pray for the 10 faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God's Word, and shepherd the flock (Phil. 1:3-5). Pray for their families, and their children in particular to be converted (Rom. 10:9-10) and grow in their knowledge and affection for Jesus.

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Philippians 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.
