

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

<u>VBS:</u> Pray for the Lord to provide the volunteers and the kids to make a successful VBS starting June 10. May he see fit to use this effort to encourage believing kids in their young faith, convict unbelieving kids to repent and believe, and show the excellence of Christ to kids who have never heard the gospel before. Pray that non-Christian families will attend, be compelled by the gospel, and come to join our congregation through repentance and faith.

<u>Our Finances:</u> Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Rom. 13:12).

Marriages in Our Congregation: Pray for those in our church who are married. Pray that our earthly marriages would showcase the wonders of God's love for us in Christ. Pray that husbands and wives would powerfully put on display the covenant love between Christ and his bride the church (Eph. 5:22-33). Pray for those who are struggling in their marriage, that they would seek the help they need to strengthen their marriage. Even as we face increasing cultural pressures, pray we would continue to uphold God's good design to us in gender, and that we would celebrate the God-given gifts of both marriage and singleness (Gen. 2:15-25; 1 Cor. 7:8, 17-35).

<u>Our Faith:</u> Pray that our faith will continue to increase and grow (Luke 17:5, Romans 4:20). Ask that by his grace, we will trust in the good news and the many promises of his word so that we may receive all the intended benefits (Hebrews 4:2). Pray that as we face various trials our faith will prove genuine and result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ (1 Peter 1:7).

Those Struggling with Addictions: Pray for those in our midst who are struggling with addictions. Pray that they would bring their struggles and frustrations to Jesus (Matt. 11:28-30). Pray they would repent of their sins and seek forgiveness (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray they would find practical wisdom (Prov. 3:21-23) and supportive friends in our church family (1 Thess. 5:11) that can help them live a stable, addiction-free, God-pleasing life (Phil. 2:12-16).
