WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Youth: Pray for the students that will be attending D3 camp this week. Pray that they would grow in their understanding of the knowledge of God and his word. Pray that God would enlighten the eyes of their hearts, so that they might know what is the hope in Christ that God gives to those who believe (Eph. 1:17-20). Pray that they would grow in their understanding of what it means to be a disciple of Christ.

Our Congregational Singing: Pray that we would be a church that delights to "sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly" (Psalm 149:1). Pray that we would sing with full hearts as an act of love toward God and toward one another.
