WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Worshipful Church: In light of Revelation 4 and 5, pray that the Lord would arrest our attention with himself. Ask that we might know more of Him and that our lives would better reflect that knowledge. May our vision of God be ever growing, ever reaching further toward His infinite majesty.

The Congregational Meeting: As our church gathers this evening, pray that we can continue to glorify Jesus and love one another well. Pray for our witness to the outside world to be one of gospel clarity and Christlike compassion. Pray for our ministry to one another to deepen and strengthen.

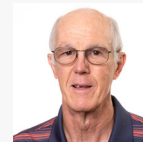
