WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Witnessing Church: Reflect upon Revelation 6:15-17 and what it will be like when Jesus returns for those who have rejected him. Pray that our church will have a renewed love and compassion for lost souls and an eager desire to share the message of salvation. Pray that many doors will open for the word and that we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Colossians 3:3-4). Pray that many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted.

For the Nations: Pray that all the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord and that every family of every nation will worship the Lord (Psalm 22:27). Pray that every people, nation, and language will serve King Jesus (Dan. 7:14). Choose one nation in particular and pray for it each day this week that Jesus might be glorified there and much good would come to the people. Rejoice and praise God that by his blood, Jesus has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation (Rev. 5:9).

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord and an integral part of our church family. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matt. 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil and the pressures of the world that are especially challenging to our youth (Eph. 6:11). Pray that they will flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Tim. 2:22).

Our Deacons: Pray for the men and women who faithfully serve as our deacons. Pray for their ministry of service to our church family, as they visit the sick, distribute from the benevolence fund, work to strengthen our unity, pray for our people, provide for tangible needs, etc. (Acts 6:1-7).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Rom. 13:12).

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Call to Worship & Prayer of Adoration

We do not invite ourselves to worship God; rather, God has called us to worship Him. God initiates; we respond. He has the first and last word in meeting with us.
