WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Conversions: Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Recognize your great need for a Merciful Savior. Celebrate the good news of the Cross.
